In Tuesday's election, there are two amendments of concern to the Christian voter:

According to the Secretary of State's office:

Amend. 1, if approved by a majority of yes votes, would allow the lawful display of the Ten Commandments on state / public property or in public schools. If approved, the amendment also prohibits the state from spending public money to defend the measure in court if challenged.

Amend. 2, if approved by a majority of yes votes, would change the state constitution to say the broad public policy of the state is to support the rights of the unborn & specify the **constitution does not protect an individual's** right to abortion or require funding of abortion.
