Pray for all of the children and workers in Vacation Bible School this week.

George Barna once reported:

- > Nearly half of all Americans who accept Jesus Christ as their savior do so before reaching the age of 13 (43%).
- > Two out of three born again Christians (64%) made that commitment to Christ before their 18th birthday.
- > One out of eight born again people (13%) made their profession of faith while 18 to 21 years old.
- > Less than one out of every four born again Christians (23%) embraced Christ after their twenty-first birthday.


