There will be a special called church conference Sunday, January 30 to consider the following recommendations:

The Finance Committee, Deacons, and 3rd Floor Construction Committee recommend that the church approve the construction of the 3rd floor for the youth at an estimated cost of \$300,000 to be funded by the Building Fund, which has a current balance of \$130,000. The above also recommend that a special offering to the Building Fund be received the first Sunday of March with a goal of \$50,000 to bring the amount in hand to 60% of the estimated cost and then begin the project, with the balance to be paid from gifts to the Building Fund during the months required for construction with the goal of not incurring debt.
